## **Transitions**





Children have started to transition to new rooms.

Sometimes this change can be scary for young children, some children will be excited for the change, but others may find it challenging. This transition means changes to routines, new educators but also new opportunities to play and grow!

Our team do their best to support children during this period to ensure a smooth transition. Children begin with short visits into their new environment with current educators, this allows them to participate in the program and helps them to become familiar with new educators and the space.

A few things you can do to support your child.

- Talk to your child about moving to the next room, this can help them get used to the idea. (name the new room)
- Introduce yourself to new educators.
- Talk about things your child may do in the room (new toys, friends and experiences)

These sessions allow you to engage in the program and support your child to feel safe and secure in their new environment.
